



Information sheet for exhibitors and stand builders

Ladies and Gentlemen, dear Exhibitors,

Here is some important information and rules to follow to ensure that the assembly and dismantling of SIAMS 2026 runs smoothly:

Assembly

External standbulders: Easter 2026 will take place two weeks before the opening of SIAMS. The stands in **halls 1.1** and **1.0 must be set up by 7.04.2025** (week 15).

For halls 1.2, 2.1 and 2.2, they will have to be installed from 30.03.2025 (before Easter) and until 11.04.2026 (end of week 15).

Stands must be completed by Monday 20.04.2026 17:00 and empty packaging taken back or stored on site.

For halls 1.1, 2.1 and 2.2, an assembly schedule will be drawn up in line with the deliveries of heavy machines. We will be informing exhibitors in these three halls about this at the end of February.

All halls will be closed over Easter (03.04.2026 - 06.04.2026) and at weekends: 28-29.03.2026 and 11-12.04.2026.

Monday 20.04.2026: all halls close at 17:00

(Exit obligatory for everyone)

Dismantling:

Stands may be dismantled from Saturday 25.04.2026 at 7.30 a.m. and must be completed in accordance with the schedule on our website.

All rented furniture must be emptied by Wednesday 29.04.2026 after the show closes.

They will be taken away the same day.

It is essential that you observe these rules:

The surface area of the stand must not be exceeded under any circumstances (Syma construction system, 92mm frames), see SIAMS Regulations, art. 11 et seq..

The rear and side walls must be white and clean above 2,5m on the outside of the stand.

On Tuesday 28 April 2026, only heavy machinery delivery lorries (according to schedule) for all halls will be allowed on site. **No other collections will be permitted on this day.**

All delivery vehicles must have a completed 'Delivery/Collection' form visible on the windscreen (available on our website).

From Monday 13.04.2026, a deposit of CHF 100 will be required. This will be collected by Securitas staff (cash payment only).
